for graduating seniors (one who plays baseball and one who plays football)*

The **Friends of John Ponte Memorial Scholarship** seeks to recognize students who meet the criteria of excellence in both academics and student athletes.

Selection is based on: a) academic performance, b) leadership, c) participation in school activities, d) character, and e) participation in sports.

To be eligible for the **Friends of John Ponte Memorial Scholarship**, applicants must:

1. Plan to matriculate at an accredited school of higher education;
2. Demonstrate a strong record for four years of high school;
3. Submit an application to the Guidance Office **by April 1, 2021**;
4. Submit two letters of recommendation (only one from a teacher) that speak to the applicant's character, leadership, ability to work with people, study habits, and citizenship;
5. Obtain an additional letter from a school counselor showing an interest in higher education and academic achievement;
6. Submit a high school academic transcript.
